Exam Instructions

- All three exams will be online and multiple choice (on Brightspace).
- Do not use hand-held devices to take the exams. They may not work properly.
- There will be a practice exam in the first week of classes. It will have some rather trivial questions from General Physics 1. It is meant for everyone to get used to this kind of online exams. It is required and must be taken by the end of the day on the Saturday of the first week. However, its score will not be included for the final grade.
- For the actual exams, you may sign on at any time on the day of the exam.
- Before signing on for the exam make sure you have **pencil**, **paper and a calculator** ready to work out the problems. Also find a **quiet place** to take the exam where you will not be disturbed for the duration of the exam.
- Once you sign on to take the exam, you will have a limited duration to finish it.
- By design, the exam can be finished in less than half the allotted time.
- There may be more than one correct answer for each question.
- Some answers are incomplete and worth partial credit.
- There will be about 12 questions for each of the first two exams and about 20 questions for the final exam.
- There can be up to 10 choices for answers to a single question.
- All necessary formulae will be provided using usual notation. No explanations of formulae will be given.
- You may use the textbook. However, it may only waste time as the necessary formulae will be given.
